- Submitting this for your approval and making any further amendments so that the final Design Plan can be undertaken.
- This drawing can also be used for obtaining costs from contractors either by you or myself and attaining planning permission if required.
- Discussing any contractual arrangements.



INTRODUCTION

All the pools are a joy to see and pure bliss in which to swim.


In addition they provide considerable health benefits as they do not contain chlorine or other chemicals!



DESIGN

Having an overall design prepared for the pool and the immediate surroundings, ensures that it is part of the garden or landscape, and that it is aesthetically pleasing at all times of the year. Even in winter when it is frozen and there is snow on the ground.

It is very important that the pool is sited in a sheltered location, especially from cold winds. Landform, planting, walls and fences all can play a major role in the overall design to provide a suitable micro-climate in which to enjoy the pool and



The design takes all these and much more into account such as – who uses the pool, the area selected for the pool, the ground conditions, the need for sun and shade, the location of the services and many more.

The size of the pool will be determined by the client’s requirements, such as having a good length for exercise, the right depth for diving, a shallow area for children and learners. Space will also play an important part in the size and shape. Consideration is given to sun decks, terraces and patios as well as the surface treatment around the pool, to ensure that they are all harmonious.
